BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Exemption of the Sale or Exchange of Books from the

3 Secondhand and Pawn Dealers Registration and Reporting Requirements

4 For the purpose of creating an exemption of the sale or exchange of books from the registration
5 and reporting requirements as secondhand and pawn dealers under the County Code.

6 BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

7 SUBTITLE 5. BUSINESSES AND LICENSES

8 Section 5-235,

9 The Prince George's County Code

10 (2003 Edition, 2006 Supplement).

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
12 Maryland, that Section 5-235 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby
13 repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

14 SUBTITLE 5. BUSINESSES AND LICENSES.

15 DIVISION 19. SECONDHAND AND PAWN DEALERS.

16 **Sec. 5-235. Exceptions.**

17 (a) This Division shall have no application to the exchange of an item described in Section
18 5-233 if:

19 * * * * *

20 (b) This Division shall have no application to the sale or exchange of books, periodicals or
21 other written materials.

1 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby
2 declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph,
3 sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of
4 competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining
5 words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this
6 Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such
7 invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, subparagraph, subsection, or section.

8 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)
9 calendar days after it becomes law.
