Transportation, Housing and Environment Committee

Date 10/9/2012

Committee Vote: Favorable 5-0 with amendments (In favor: Council Members Toles, Patterson, Davis, Olson and Lehman)

A summary of the Proposed Amendments was provided, reflected in Amendment #2 (Council Member Lehman) adopting the International Energy Conservation Code (IECC) local amendments and comments that were received. Council and Departmental staff provided additional information to the Committee in response to questions by members.

The Committee received written comments, dated October 9th from the Maryland-National Building Industry Association (M-NCBIA) and verbal comments by Hammer Campbell, Vice-President. Lesa Hoover, Vice-President, Apartment and Office Building Association of Metropolitan Washington (AOBA), also provided testimony regarding concerns on CB-45-2012 and the proposed Amendment #2.

The Committee adopted CB-45-2012 with Amendment #1 and #2 as reflected in Draft 2.

September 27th, 2012

Committee Action: Held

The Committee reviewed a list of issues and discussion points from the September 27th THE Committee meeting with Sarah Bouldin-Carr, Kina Campbell, and Harvey Middleton from Department of Environmental Resources (DER) as it relates to THE Committee Amendments #1 (Departmental) regarding permit administration requirements.

The Committee received written comment, dated September 27th from the Maryland-National Building Industry Association (M-NCBIA) represented by Hammer Campbell.

The Office of Audits and Investigation indicated there will be minimal negative fiscal impact on the County as a result of enactment of CB-45-2012.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

(Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)

This legislation adopts the 2012 International Building Codes and provides local amendments to be used for construction in Prince George's County. The Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development requires the adoption of the latest version of the International Codes under COMAR, 05.02.07, Maryland Building Performance Standards. The adoption of the International Building Codes is needed in anticipation of construction permits for several important County projects. The new Codes will assure that construction is performed under the most recent life safety regulations and construction standards.
