REPORT: Committee Vote: Favorable, 3-0 (Council Members Fisher, Hunter, and Oriadha). Absent: Burrough and Blegay

The Prince George's County Council's Health, Human Services, and Public Safety Committee convened on February 19, 2026, to consider CR-004-2026, a resolution concerning the County Council's rules of procedure to amend the County Council's Rules of Procedure.

The purpose of this legislation is to provide for a revised committee name that reflects the importance of public safety as a critical part of our budget and policy matters and is more representative of the work of this committee.

The Office of Law, represented by Dinora Hernandez, found CR-004-2026 to be legally sufficient with no legal impediments to enactment. The Office of the County Executive, represented by Council Liaison Sonia Owens, took no position on the legislation.

After a motion by Committee Chair Fisher and a second by Council Member Hunter, the Health, Human Services and Public Safety Committee voted CR-004-2026 out favorably, 3-0.
