BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 The Classification Plan for Prince George's County

3 For the purpose of assigning certain existing classes of work to the bargaining unit represented
 4 by the Deputy Sheriff's Association of Prince George's County, Inc. (Civilian Units).

5 WHEREAS, the County Executive, pursuant to Section 903 of the Prince George's County
 6 Charter and Section 16-125(a) of Subtitle 16 of the Prince George's County Code, has in order to
 7 provide better governmental services, recommended to the County Council amendments to the
 8 Classification Plan for Prince George's County, Maryland with respect to the classes of work
 9 described in Section 1 of this bill, in accordance with the Amendment of Certification issued by
 10 the Prince George's County Public Employee Relations Board (PERB) on December 22, 2000
 11 for positions in the bargaining unit represented by Deputy Sheriff's Association; and

12 WHEREAS, the County Executive, pursuant to Section 903 of the Prince George's County
 13 Charter and Section 16-125(a) of Subtitle 16 of the Prince George's County Code, has
 14 recommended to the County Council amendments to the Classification Plan for Prince George's
 15 County, Maryland with respect to the classes of work described in Section 2 of this bill, subject
 16 to an Amendment of Certification by the PERB pursuant to the Collective Bargaining Agreement
 17 between Prince George's County, Maryland and the Deputy Sheriff's Association of Prince
 18 George's County, Inc. for positions in the bargaining unit represented by Deputy Sheriff's
 19 Association of Prince George's County, Inc. (Civilian Units) now, therefore,

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
 21 Maryland, that the Classification Plan for Prince George's County, Maryland be and the same is

hereby amended as follows:

Administrative Assistant I, Z-18

(\$29,291 - \$45,594)

2516Z Administrative Assistant II, Z-21

(\$33,909 - \$52,781)

2517Z Administrative Assistant III, Z-24

(\$39,253 - \$61,100)

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Classification Plan for Prince George's County be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

3289Z Investigator I, Z-18

(\$30,325 - \$47,427)

3290Z Investigator II, Z-21

(\$35,106 - \$54,904)

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law and that the amendment of Section 1 of this Act shall be retroactive to December 22, 2000.

SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law and that the amendment of Section 2 of this Act shall be retroactive to July 1, 2001.
