BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

CB-99-1998, presented in July, would require that all public school construction contracts in excess of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) be subject to State of Maryland prevailing wage rates.

CB-99-1998 was tabled in the Health, Education and Human Services (HEHS) Committee largely over concerns regarding the potential fiscal impact of this proposal on the County's school construction program. This resolution would provide for the services of an outside consultant to study in greater detail potential impacts from establishing the use of State prevailing wages on school construction projects.
