PLANNING, ZONING & ECON. DEV. COMMITTEE REPORT

DATE: 6/16/97

Committee Vote: Favorable as amended, 3-0 (In favor: Council Members Del Giudice, Maloney and Wilson).

Staff presented a Draft 2 of this resolution to the Committee. DR-2 amends Line 4 on Page 2 to eliminate "the residential parking." This amendment was necessary since the amendments to Chapter 12 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Mount Rainier do not address parking, only fences.

The Legislative Officer and the Office of Law find the legislation to be in proper legal form. The

Planning Board supports the legislation.
The Committee voted favorably on DR-2.

This is a resolution to approve amendments to the City of Mount Rainier's code. The resolution will approve the enactment of Ordinance 4-97, amending Chapter 12 of the Code of Ordinances of the City concerning fences.
