WHEREAS, durin	g the Fiscal Year 1994 Bi-County budget process the Montgomery and		
Prince George's County	Councils established a Bi-County Working Group to recommend		
changes that would control the growth of debt and maintain future rate increases at WSSC close			
to the level of inflation;	and		
WHEREAS, the Working Group's January 1994 Report recommended the establishment of			
a spending affordability	process; and		
WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council endorsed the entire Working Group's			
report through the adoption of CR-12-1994 and the Montgomery Council endorsed part			
of the report's recomme	ndations through Resolution #12-1558; and		
WHEREAS, the Councils jointly endorsed in concept the January 1994 Working Group			
Report spending afforda	ability process; and		
WHEREAS, both	Councils endorsed the utilization of the spending affordability process		
beginning with the form	nulation of the Fiscal Year 1996 budget; and		
WHEREAS, the Spending Affordability Working Group, consisting of the staffs of the			
Montgomery and Prince George's County Councils and both County Executive's offices, make			
certain recommendations on the WSSC Fiscal Year 2018 Operating and Capital Budgets; and			

1 WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council and the Montgomery Council have 2 reviewed the information compiled by the staff relating to spending control limits on the 3 percentage of water and sewer increase; new debt; debt service and operating expenditures; 4 WHEREAS, on October 27, 2016, the Transportation, Housing and Environment 5 Committee discussed the spending control limits for WSSC's FY 2018 Capital and Operating 6 Budgets and made recommendations to the Council. 7 WHEREAS, the Prince Georges County Council supports the completion of WSSC's 8 ongoing Comprehensive Rate Study with an implementation goal of FY 2019. 9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's 10 County, Maryland, that the Prince George's County Council hereby endorses the following 11 spending control limits for the Fiscal Year 2018 Water and Sewer Operating and Capital Budgets 12 of the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission: 13 14 Water and Sewer Bill increase: three point five percent (3.5%) 15 New Water and Sewer Debt: Five hundred and seventy million, and 16 twenty two thousand 17 (\$570,022,000) 18 Water and Sewer Debt Service: Two hundred and sixty million, four 19 hundred and fifty seven thousand dollars 20 (\$260,457,000) 21 Water and Sewer Operating Seven hundred and thirty million, 22 Fund Expenditures: five hundred and twenty two thousand 23 dollars (\$730,522,000) 24
