RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 The Prince George's County portion of the Fiscal Year 2003

3 Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission budget

4 For the purpose of amending the Fiscal Year 2003 Prince George's County Planning
 5 Department's Special Revenue Fund Budget.

6 WHEREAS, The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission (M-NCPPC),
 7 Prince George's County Government, Montgomery County Government and the Washington
 8 Suburban Sanitary Commission (WSSC) continue to work under an agreement to develop and
 9 maintain a Geographic Information System (GIS); and

10 WHEREAS, under this agreement, each of the parties agreed to develop, fund, and
 11 maintain a number of basic layers of the system, which were deemed necessary for a successful
 12 system; and

13 WHEREAS, each of the parties was enabled to use the layers for their internal purposes and
 14 could develop other layers, with all layers to be jointly shared; and

15 WHEREAS, several years ago, the Prince George's County Planning Department of the M-
 16 NCPPC and the Prince George's County Government agreed to update the topographic layer
 17 with two-foot contours and the planimetric layer; and

18 WHEREAS, the update was completed last year through the use of contractors retained
 19 and managed by the Prince George's County Planning Department of the M-NCPPC; and

20 WHEREAS, recently Prince George's County Government agreed to execute an agreement
 21 with the State Highway Administration (SHA) and the Federal Emergency Management Agency
 22 (FEMA) to share the updated layers with these two agencies for their internal use at a total cost

1 of \$358,250; and

2 WHEREAS, the M-NCPPC did not budget for the revenue to be generated through the
3 sharing of the updated layers pursuant to the agreement between Prince George's County
4 Government, SHA and FEMA; and

5 WHEREAS, periodic updates of the basic system will continue to be necessary in the future
6 in order to maintain a current system; and

7 WHEREAS, a special revenue fund has been established in the Planning Department in
8 accordance with GASB #34 for the purpose of maintaining the basic system; and

9 WHEREAS, the \$358,250 will be set aside in this fund specifically for the purpose of
10 funding the next update of the basic system,

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
12 County, Maryland, that the Prince George's County Planning Department's GIS Special
13 Revenue Fund revenue budget for Fiscal Year 2003 be amended to increase by \$358,250, which
14 represents Prince George's County Government's, SHA's and FEMA's share of the cost to
15 update the topographic layer with two-foot contours and the planimetric layer.
