AN ORDINANCE concerning			
	Trucking Operations		
For the purpose of amending the definition of trucking operations and repealing all provisions of			
the Zoning Ordinance concerning truck marshalling, by repealing in part CB-13-2000 and			
repealing in its entirety CB-20-2000.			
BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:			
Section 27-107.01 (a),			
The Zoning Ordinance of Prince George's County, Maryland,			
being also

The Prince George's County Code			
(1999 Edition, 2002 Supplement).			
WHEREAS, Council Bill 13-2000 was enacted on June 6, 2000, to amend certain			
definitions in Section 27-107.01 (a) of the Zoning Ordinance concerning trucking operations, and			
for other purposes; and			
WHEREAS, Council Bill 20-2000 was enacted on April 11, 2000, to amend the definition			
of public buildings and uses in Section 27-107.01 (a) of the Zoning Ordinance; and			
WHEREAS, after review of the definitions in Section 27-107.01 (a), the District Council			
has determined that the amendments made in CB-13-2000 and CB-20-2000 are unnecessary and			
should be repealed.			

1	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,		
2	Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional		
3	District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that Section 27-107.01 (a) of the Zoning		
4	Ordinance is hereby repealed and reenacted as follows:

9	(a) Terms in the Zoning Ordinance are defined as follows:

11	(185) Public Buildings and Uses: Any land, "Building," or "Structure" used for public		
12	purposes by any agency, department, or branch of County, State, Municipal, or Federal		
13	Government[; but not including any vehicle or trailer parking, storage, or marshalling use which		
14	does not serve a public building or use in the County].		
15	* * * * * * * * *		
16	(243.4) [Truck Marshalling: The temporary parking or storage on a property of trucks		
17	or other vehicles which transport goods to or from another property, such as an office building,		
18	retail or wholesale center, or meeting or convention site. The vehicles are temporarily parked or		
19	stored at the "Truck Marshalling" property before they are driven to the property being served,		
20	where the transported goods are loaded or unloaded. "Truck Marshalling" is not permitted		
21	within the County to serve properties outside the County.		
22	(243.5)] <b>Trucking Operation</b> : Any facility, other than the administrative offices, of a		
23	business established for the purpose of carting, hauling, moving, or otherwise transporting goods,		
24	materials, equipment, supplies, possessions, vehicles, or other items by truck for compensation.		
25	A "Motor Freight" company is a "Trucking Operation." No storage building used by a "Trucking		
26	Operation" shall be considered a "Distribution Facility" or "Warehouse Unit." [A "Trucking		
27	Operation" may not include "Truck Marshalling" which serves a use or a property outside the		
28	County.]

30	SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall take effect on the		
31	date of its adoption.
