Committee Vote: Favorable, 4-0 (In favor: Council Members Franklin, Harrison, Hawkins, and Turner)

The Planning, Housing and Economic Development Committee convened on September 15, 2022, to consider the appointment of Ms. Madye G. Henson, a resident of Upper Marlboro, to the Redevelopment Authority Board of Prince George's County. The Redevelopment Authority is established pursuant to Subtitle 15B of the County Code. The Authority's goal is to stimulate revitalization in the County's older communities. The Authority's Board acquires land and property within the County for residential, commercial, or industrial development or redevelopment of these communities.

Ms. Miriam Brewer, Appointments Liaison for the Office of the County Executive, introduced Ms. Henson providing brief biographical information for the nominee. Ms. Henson shared her interest and qualifications for serving on the Redevelopment Authority Board and responded to Council Members' questions. The Committee thanked Ms. Henson for her willingness to serve.

After discussion, the Committee voted favorable, 4-0, in favor of Ms. Henson's appointment to the Redevelopment Authority Board of Prince George's County.
