Committee Vote: Favorable, 4-0 (In favor: Council Members Dean, Knotts, Bland, and Olson)

Staff explained that the resolution approves an amendment to Chapter 130 of the City of Glenarden Code concerning residential storage. The City adopted Ordinance O-07-2010 on May 10, 2010 for the purpose of adopting regulations for portable storage containers and dumpsters on residential property. Section 8-112.1 of Article 28 of the Maryland Annotated Code requires District Council approval of the City's ordinance before it becomes effective.

The Office of Audits and Investigations reviewed CR-99-2010 and determined that adoption of this resolution will not have an adverse fiscal impact on Prince George's County.
