A RESOLUTION concerning

Indian Head Highway - Maryland Route 210

For the purpose of expressing the sense of the County Council regarding the construction of improvements to major intersections with Indian Head Highway - Maryland Route 210 between the Capital Beltway and Maryland Route 228.

WHEREAS, the Charles County Board of County Commissioners, the Prince George's County Council and the Prince George's County Executive support the construction of additional lanes for Maryland Route 228 between the Charles County - Prince George's County boarder and Maryland Route 210; and

WHEREAS, when road improvements are completed on Maryland Route 228, it is expected that traffic on Maryland Route 210 will increase; and

WHEREAS, peak traffic volumes on Maryland Route 210 at several major intersections has resulted in a failure of those intersections, especially the intersections at Old Fort Road, Palmer Road, and Livingston Road; and

WHEREAS, the current state of disrepair of Maryland Route 210 and the burdensome volume of traffic pose a real and daily threat to the safety and lives of motorists and pedestrian who use the Indian Head Highway corridor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that improvements to the intersections of Indian Head Highway - Maryland Route 210 with Old Fort Road, Palmer Road, Livingston Road and other major intersections should commence and be completed by the State Department of Transportation in concert

with

improvements to Maryland Route 228 between the Charles County - Prince George's County
boarder and Maryland Route 210.
