SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,

109, 15-110, 15-111, 15-112, 15-113, 15-114, 15-115, 15-116, 15-117, and 15-118 of the
Prince George's County Code be and the same are hereby repealed:
