George's County, N	ryland, creating a County tax credit against the property tax imposed on the	e
real property that is	sed as the premises of manufacturing, fabricating, or assembling facilities	
that locate or expan	in the County and meet certain criteria; and	
WHEREAS, S	ction 2 of Chapter 56, 1998 Laws of Prince George's County, Maryland,	
imposed a July 1, 20	11 deadline for applications for the tax credit; and	
WHEREAS, C	apter 28, 2001 Laws of Prince George's County, Maryland, extended that	
deadline for applica	ons to July 1, 2003; and	
WHEREAS, th	County Executive has recommended renewed acceptance of applications	

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for the tax credit; now therefore,

1	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,		
2	Maryland, that Section 2 of Chapter 28, 2001 Laws of Prince George's County, Maryland, be
