George's Plaza Metro	orail Station, has made application for property described as 22.04 acres of	
land in the M-X-T ar	nd T-D-O Zones, the subject of CSP-02001 and DSP-04004, where 263	
luxury multifamily r	esidential units will be constructed; and	
WHEREAS, ce	ensus tract number 805901 lies within the Revitalization Tax Credit District
