6	business where massages are administered for pay, including massage parlors, exercise clubs,								
7	spas, health clubs, sauna baths, and steam baths. This term shall not include:								
8	(A) A "Hospital," "Nursing or Care Home," or "Medical Clinic";								
9	(B) The office of a physician, surgeon, chiropractor, osteopath, podiatrist, o								
10	physical or massage therapist duly licensed or certified by the State of Maryland;								
11	(C) A barber shop or beauty salon in which massages are administered only to								
12	the scalp, face, neck, or shoulders;								
13	(D) A volunteer fire department or volunteer rescue squad;								
14	(E) A nonprofit organization operating an educational, cultural, recreational, o								
15	athletic facility;								
16	(F) A facility for the welfare of the residents of the area; or								
17	(G) An establishment providing instruction in, and facilities for, controlled								
18	exercise, weight lifting, calisthenics, and general physical fitness, which occupies at least five								
19	thousand (5,000) square feet, of which not more than five percent (5%) is used for massages; and								
20	whose gross income from massages is less than fifteen percent (15%) of the total gross business								
21	income derived from physical fitness sales contracts at each business location.								
22	(147.1) Massage Therapist (Certified): An individual who is certified by the State								
23	of Maryland Board of Chiropractic Examiners to practice massage therapy.
