AN ACT concerning

Unobstructed Accessible Routes to Buildings

For the purpose of establishing civil fines and penalties for violations of County laws and ordinances concerning unobstructed accessible routes to buildings.

By adding:

SUBTITLE 28. CIVIL MONETARY FINES OR PENALTIES.

Section 28-263,

The Prince George's County Code (1987 Edition, 1990 Supplement).

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that Section 28-263 of the Prince

George's County Code be and the same is hereby added to the Prince George's County Code.

SUBTITLE 28. CIVIL MONETARY FINES OR PENALTIES.

DIVISION 3. MISCELLANEOUS CIVIL VIOLATIONS.

Subdivision 2. Specific Civil Penalties Prescribed.

Sec. 28-263. Unobstructed Building Access Violations.

- (a) Any person who violates Section 4-123 (a) (9) of this Code concerning unobstructed accessible routes to buildings shall, upon citation issued pursuant to Subdivision 1, be deemed to have committed a civil violation and shall pay to the County a civil monetary fine in the amount prescribed by Subsection (b) of this Section.
- (1) Each separate day of violation that remains
 uncorrected is a distinct civil violation subject to an additional
 citation and fine in the amount prescribed by Subsection (b) of this
 section.
- (b) The civil monetary fine for each civil violation of the County Code concerning unobstructed accessible routes for disabled persons to buildings shall be One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), except as provided in Subsection (c).
- (c) For a repeated civil violation, at the same location, within a twelve (12) month period the following fines shall apply:

 2nd violation
 \$ 250.00

 3rd violation
 \$ 500.00

Each violation in excess of three \$1,000.00

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take

effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes	law
