A RESOLUTION concerning		

State of Maryland Sustainable Community Designation For the purpose of approving the designation of a portion of Prince George's County as a Sustainable Community by the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development ("DHCD").

WHEREAS, the State of Maryland Sustainable Communities Act of 2010 established the Sustainable Community Designation to focus State revitalization resources to targeted areas proposed by a sponsor and approved by the Smart Growth Subcabinet; and

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Executive and County Council recognize that there is a significant need for reinvestment and revitalization of the County's established residential and commercial neighborhoods and investment in transit-oriented development; and

WHEREAS, the Montgomery County Government, in partnership with Prince George's County and nine Montgomery County municipalities, has proposed the designation of portions of Montgomery County and that portion of Prince George's County included within the Takoma Langley Crossroads sector plan, shown on the map attached as Attachment 'A', as a single Sustainable Community (the "Area"), as shown on the map attached as Attachment 'B'; and

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Executive and County Council support the development of a Sustainable Community Plan (the "Plan"), the purpose of which will be to contribute to the reinvestment and revitalization of the Area; and

WHEREAS, DHCD, in cooperation with other State departments or agencies, may provide some or all of the financing for the Plan to assist in making identified projects financially feasible within the Area; and

21 22 WHEREAS, the Area is located within a priority funding area under Section 5-7B-02 of the Smart Growth Act and the Projects will conform to the local zoning code; and

WHEREAS, applicable law and program regulations provide that an application for a sustainable community plan that affects a sustainable community within more than one political subdivision may not be approved unless each political subdivision approves it by resolution; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, hereby approves and endorses the application of Montgomery County, Maryland, submitted to the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development for designation of the Area as a single Sustainable Community.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to the Secretary of the Department of Housing and Community Development of the State of Maryland for consideration by the Smart Growth Subcabinet.
