EMERGENCY BILL

1 AN EMERGENCY ACT concerning

2 Supplementary Appropriations

3 For the purpose of appropriating to the General Fund revenue to provide for costs that were not
4 anticipated in the approved Fiscal Year 2002-2003 Budget.

5 WHEREAS, CB-49-2002, as amended, adopted and enacted the Annual Budget and
6 Appropriation Ordinance of Prince George’s County for Fiscal Year 2002-2003, which set forth
7 the amount of appropriations and revenue estimates, said appropriation and revenue estimates to
8 be adjusted as hereinafter set forth; and

9 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 815 of the Charter of Prince George’s County, Maryland,
10 the County Council may, by Legislative Act, make additional or supplementary appropriations
11 from revenue received from anticipated sources but in excess of budget estimates therefor, from
12 revenues received from sources not anticipated in the budget for the current fiscal year, and from
13 any prior year available and uncommitted fund balance; and

14 WHEREAS, the additional appropriations as provided herein, and certain additional
15 revenue have been identified; and

16 WHEREAS, the County Executive has duly recommended that the supplementary
17 appropriation be made; now, therefore

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
19 Maryland, that the following adjustments to revenue estimates for Fiscal Year 2002-2003 for the
20 General Fund, as expressed in CB-49-2002, as amended, are made:

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that in accordance with the provisions of Section 317 of the Charter, the County Council hereby declares that a public emergency exists affecting the public health, safety, and welfare; said emergency being the need to provide funding to Dimensions Health Corporation in order to support the continuation of essential health services for the citizens and residents of Prince George's County. As the largest provider of inpatient and emergency services, Dimensions Health Corporation is a cornerstone in the health care system in the County. Access to quality health care for the citizens and residents of the County depends on the continuation of Dimensions Health Corporation services. For the past several years, Dimensions Health Corporation has been facing serious financial difficulties resulting in significant operating losses. County funding in Fiscal Year 2003, in the amount of \$3,000,000 is necessary to assist Dimensions Health Corporation with operating costs. Without this supplementary appropriation funding, Dimensions Health Corporation will face increased difficulty in funding vital short-term operating needs that could affect access to care.

SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect on the date it becomes law.

Adopted this 29th day of April, 2003, by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of the full County Council.
