Council Bill 13 was presented by Council Member Harrington and referred to the Planning, Zoning and Economic Development Committee. (PZED).

<u>CB-14-2004 – AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING R-R ZONE</u> for the purpose of allowing townhouses in the R-R Zone under certain circumstances. <u>PRESENTED</u>

Council Bill 14 was presented by Council Member Harrington and referred to the Planning, Zoning and Economic Development Committee. (PZED).

Council Member Knotts proposed that a letter be sent to Mr. Charles Renninger, Chairman of the Environmental Justice Task Force, authorizing an extension of the submittal date of the Task Force Report. Council Member Dean moved to authorize the Chairman's signature; seconded by Council Member Exum the motion carried 8-0 (Absent: Council Member Hendershot)

SECOND READING OF BILLS (INTRODUCTION)

<u>CB-9-2004 – AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING C-O ZONE</u> for the purpose of permitting a swimming pool accessory to a hotel or motel in the C-O Zone. <u>INTRODUCED</u>

Council Member Dernoga, as Chairman of the Planning Zoning and Economic Development Committee, provided the Council Members with a verbal report of the Committee's actions and recommendations. Council Bill 9 amends the Zoning Ordinance to permit a swimming pool accessory to a hotel or motel in the C-O Zone. The bill corrects an anomaly in the ordinance, which permits hotels in the C-O Zone, subject to site plan review, but prohibits swimming pools accessory to hotels in that zone. Council Bill 9 was favorably reported out of the Planning, Zoning and Economic Development Committee (PZED) on 03/03/2004. Council Bill 9 was introduced by Council Members Peters, Harrington and Knotts.

<u>COUNSEL</u> for the purpose of amending the appointment procedure for the People's Zoning Counsel, providing for the role of Deputy People's Zoning Counsel, and amending the compensation provisions. <u>INTRODUCED</u>

Council Member Dernoga, as Chairman of the Planning Zoning and Economic Development Committee, provided the Council Members with a verbal report of the Committee's actions and recommendations. Council Bill 10 provides for the role of the Deputy People's Zoning Counsel and removes the County Executive from the appointment and compensation sections of the ordinance pertaining to the People's Zoning Counsel. Council Bill 10 was favorably reported out of Planning, Zoning and Economic Development Committee (PZED) on 03/03/2004 with amendments. Council Bill 10 Draft 2 was introduced by Council Members Knotts, Dean, Peters,

Harrington and Exum.
