BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT**(Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)**

The proposed Resolution is a companion to CB-3-2003. The Resolution, if adopted, will make the same amendments as CB-3-2003 to change the effective date provisions of existing law regarding military leave, but on a temporary basis until the permanent amendments contained in CB-3 become effective. Due to the temporary nature of the proposed Resolution and its relationship to CB-3-2003, it should be acted upon by the Council after enactment of CB-3.
