<u>CB-3-2003 – AN ACT CONCERNING MILITARY LEAVE</u> for the purpose of repealing the termination provisions of Section 4, Chapter 9, Laws of Prince George's County Maryland 2002 (CB-1-2002) concerning military leave. - <u>PRESENTED</u>

Council Bill 3 was presented by Council Member Hendershot and referred to the Public Safety and Fiscal Management Committee.

<u>CB-4-2003 – AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING R-10 ZONE</u> for the purpose of permitting retail, general offices, and parking lots and amending lot coverage requirements in the R-10 Zone under certain circumstances. - <u>PRESENTED</u>

Council Bill 4 was presented by Chairman Shapiro and referred to the Planning, Zoning and Economic Development Committee.

<u>CB-5-2003 – AN ACT CONCERNING CONFORMING AMENDMENTS TO THE</u>
<u>COUNTY CODE</u> for the purpose of making certain amendments to the County Code to conform to amendments to the County Charter approved at the 2002 General Election. - <u>PRESENTED</u>

Council Bill 5 was presented by Chairman Shapiro and referred to the Pubic Safety and Fiscal Management Committee.

<u>CODE</u> for the purpose of making technical amendments to the County Code to conform to amendments to the County Charter approved at the 2002 General Election. - <u>PRESENTED</u>

Council Bill 6 was presented by Chairman Shapiro and referred to the Pubic Safety and Fiscal Management Committee.

<u>COUNTY EXECUTIVE</u> for the purpose of making amendments to the provisions of the County Code regarding special elections to fill a vacancy on the County Council and County Executive to conform to amendments to the County Charter approved at the 2002 General Election. - <u>PRESENTED</u>

CB-8-2003 – AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING SANITARY LANDFILLS, RUBBLE FILLS AND CLASS 3 FILLS for the purpose of amending the requirements for sanitary landfills and rubble fills, defining class 3 fills and requiring a special exception for class 3 fills in all zones where they are permitted. - *PRESENTED*

<u>CR-3-2003 – A RESOLUTION CONCERNING MILITARY LEAVE</u> for the purpose of repealing the termination provisions of Section 4, Chapter 9, Laws of Prince George's County, Maryland 2002 (CB-1-2002) concerning military leave. - <u>INTRODUCED</u>

Council Resolution 3 was proposed by Council Member Hendershot and referred to the Pubic Safety and Fiscal Management Committee. Council Resolution 3, a companion to Council Bill 3, is a measure to temporarily extend existing law regarding military leave until the permanent amendments contained in Council Bill 3 become effective. Council Resolution 3 was introduced by Council Members Shapiro, Knotts, Harrington, Exum, Dean, Peters and Dernoga.
