PUBLIC SAFETY AND FISCAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT Date: 4/30/98

Committee Vote: Favorable as amended, 3-0, (In favor: Council Members Estepp, Hendershot and Wilson).

This bill is an Executive Order changing the name Fire Department to the Fire/Emergency Medical Services Department. This Executive Order consolidates related functions and highlights the increased responsibilities of emergency medical services (EMS) in the change in the functions, powers or duties of personnel in the combined department.

The legislation was amended to spell out the words "Emergency Medical Services". There should not be any negative fiscal impact on the County as a result of enacting CB-62-1998.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

This legislation will change the name of the Fire Department to the Fire/EMS Department. The Executive Order consolidates related functions and highlights the increased responsibilities of emergency medical services (EMS) in the area of fire services.
