This Bill is to adopt and approve the amendments to the collective bargaining agreement with the Deputy Sheriff's Association, Inc. (DSA) in accordance with Section 16-233(f) of the Personnel Law. The County and Deputy Sheriff's Association have amended their existing two-year labor agreement through fiscal year 1993 for the purpose of deferring pay raises and modifying other terms and conditions of employment. The detail of the cost savings resulting from this agreement will be provided by the Office of Management and Budget.
