A RESOLUTION concerning

The re-establishment of the County Solid Waste Commission

For the purpose of thoroughly reviewing the County's solid waste system and to recommend available options to contain or reduce costs while continuing to provide quality service to County residents and businesses.

WHEREAS, the County Council adopted CR-105-1994 to establish a Solid Waste Commission to review the County's solid waste disposal system; and

WHEREAS, the County Solid Waste Commission completed its assigned tasks and issued its report and recommendations to the Council; and

WHEREAS, the Commission identified a need to continue to evaluate the solid waste system and the County's recent adjustments and amendments; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to explore all available options to contain or reduce waste disposal costs for the County government and County residents and business in a financially responsible manner that does not compromise environmental standards, while continuing to provide quality services to all current and future residents and businesses in the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland that:

- 1) The County Solid Waste Commission, established by CR-105-1994, is hereby re-established.
- 2) The Solid Waste Commission consists of the thirteen members appointed in accordance with CR-105-1994 with the replacement members to be appointed by the Council

Chairman.

3) The Department of Environmental Resources and the Committee Director of the Transportation, Housing and Environment Committee shall provide staff support to the Commission.

4) The Commission shall review the processes and services established subsequent to the enactment of CB-21-1995 relating to the collection, hauling and disposal of solid waste by private contractors and recommend possible improvements. The Commission shall consider legislative initiatives of the National Association of Counties, Federal legislative and regulatory proposals, and other legal and regulatory activities which would provide the County with greater flexibility to manage solid waste disposal.

5) The Commission shall complete its work and report its findings and recommendations to County Council and County Executive at a public meeting of the Council, not later than February 28, 1997.
