WHEREAS	s, in order to address the spate of emergency events occurring throughout the	
County and region	on in recent years, there is an immediate need for a state-of-the-art emergency	
operations center	that is immediately available upon activation, and provides adequate space and	
equipment for de	signated County personnel; and	
WHEREAS	, in order to address the public safety needs of the County, there is an	
immediate need	to re-open a "Hot" 9-1-1 backup center, which is generally defied as a public	

safety command center location that is active at all times, with all required 9-1-1

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telecommunications, Computer Aided Dispatch and radio communications, software and hardware, and that is immediately available and mirrors the primary center; and

WHEREAS, the proposed center would also house the Office of Homeland Security, as the lead agency for emergency response coordination, as well as house the public safety investigations group within the Office of Human Resources Management that coordinates the recruitment process for public safety agencies; and

WHEREAS, without a "Hot" 9-1-1 backup center, emergency assistance 9-1-1- calls will go unanswered if the primary 9-1-1 center must be evacuated for any reason or there is a critical infrastructure failure; and

WHEREAS, there is substantial State support for a "Hot" 9-1-1 backup center, including the recommendation by the State Emergency Numbers System Board ('ENSB') that strongly encourages all locations to have a "Hot" back up site, and funding support from the State of approximately \$4 million for this project; and

WHEREAS, styled as CB-47-2012, the proposed project was submitted to a referendum and was approved by the qualified voters of the County at the November 2012 General Election; and

WHEREAS, the proposed backup center is a public building designed to meet the important government purpose of providing adequate public safety services for the citizens and residents of the County, and

WHEREAS, the proposed public safety facility conforms with applicable recommendations of the 2004 *Approved Morgan Boulevard and Largo Town Center Metro Areas Sector Plan and Sectional Map Amendment*; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to proceed expeditiously with the 9-1-1 backup center project in order to safeguard the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens and residents of the County; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that Section 27-122 of the Zoning Ordinance of Prince George's County, Maryland, being also Subtitle 27 of the Prince George's County Code, be and the same is repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

6	The requirements of this Subtitle shall not apply to the Prince George's Justice Center
7	complex in Hyattsville, the Greater Laurel Fire Station Building in Laurel , the Public Safety
8	Communications Center (911) and Emergency Operations Center facility on Anchor Street in
9	Landover, or to any land used by the County within the municipal limits of Upper Marlboro.
10	Site Plans for the Justice Center complex, the Greater Laurel Fire Station Building in Laurel , the
11	Public Safety Communications Center (911) and Emergency Operations Center facility on
12	Anchor Street in Landover, and for the County Administration Building or other County
13	governmental use within Upper Marlboro, shall be approved by resolution of the District
14	Council.
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SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall take effect on the
date of its adoption.
