WHEREAS	Prince George's County Government is a primary employer within Prince	e
George's County	Maryland; and	
WHEREAS	pursuant to Section 16-212 of the County Code, The County Executive s	shall
establish health	d life insurance plans for the benefit of all permanent status employees	; and
WHERE	S, given the landscape of maternal health care at the national and local	level,
there is a need to	eview the county policies and healthcare benefit options for current cour	ıty
employees, with	focus on maternal health.	

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that a Task Force be created to audit the county policies and healthcare benefit options for current county employees, with a focus on maternal health.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the County Policies and Healthcare Options Task Force shall be composed of five (5) members:

- 1. One Representative appointed by the County Council.
- 2. Director of the Health Department or designee.
- 3. Director of the Office of Human Resources Management or designee.
- 4. One Representative each from two separate organizations selected by the County Council that work on maternal health.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Task Force would compare their findings to the best practices and policies of neighboring jurisdictions.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this audit would include but not be limited to policies, procedures, and health benefits.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Policies and Healthcare Options Task Force shall meet monthly.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Policies and Healthcare Options Task
Force shall audit the county policies and healthcare benefit options for current county employees.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Policies and Healthcare Options Task Force shall submit a report to the County Council no less than 60 days from when they commence their duties.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Council reserves the right to select other members to serve on the County Policies and Healthcare Options Task Force as needed at their discretion.
