The Formation of an Agricultural District pursuant to the			

Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation Program

For the purpose of recommending that the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation approve the petition of John P. and Donna L. Denison to establish an agricultural district.

WHEREAS, a petition filed on March 4, 2004 by John P. and Donna L. Denison requested the establishment of an agricultural preservation district for approximately 132.0575 acres of land on the southwest side of Gardner Road, as generally shown on the attached location map; and

WHEREAS, the petition was referred to the Prince George's County Planning Board and the Prince George's County Agricultural Preservation Advisory Board for review and recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Planning Board found that establishment of the proposed agricultural district is compatible with existing and approved county plans and recommended approval the petition and establishment of the district; and

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Agricultural Preservation Advisory Board found that the Denison property met the qualifying criteria for productivity, size, and location as set by the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation, and recommended establishment of the agricultural district; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the 132.0575 acre tract described in the agricultural district petition filed by John P. and Donna L. Denison is recommended to the Maryland Agricultural Land

Preservation Foundation for approval; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution, copies of the petition, and copies of the letters from the Agricultural Preservation Advisory Board and the Prince George's County Planning Board, be forwarded by the Clerk of the Council to the County Executive for his consideration and, upon his approval, transmittal to the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation for appropriate action.
