The Legislative Officer provided a summary of the bill and referral comments that were received. CB-63 - 2008 exempts the sale or exchange of books from the secondhand and pawn dealer's registration and reporting requirements under the County Code.

The Office of Law determined that CB-63-2008 was in proper legislative form.

The Office of Audits and Investigation indicated there will be no adverse fiscal impact on the County as a result of adopting CB-63-2008.
