SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,			
Maryland, that Sections 2-464, 2-465, 2-466, 2-467, 2-468, 2-469, 2-470, 2-471, 2-472, and			
473 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same are hereby added:

DIVISION 37. TELECOMMUNICATIONS TRANSMISSION FACILITY

Sec. 2-464. Definitions.			
For purposes of this Division, the following words, terms, and phrases shall have the			
following meanings:

1	(a) Director means the Director of the Office of Management and Budget.		
2	(b) Minor Antenna means a radio/antenna device no more than twenty-five (25) inches in		
3	length, fifteen (15) inches in width, and ten (10) inches in height (excluding mounting brackets,		
4	fasteners, cabling and antenna), with five watts or less of transmitter output power, which is		
5	installed on streetlight arms or mast arms mounted on preexisting poles, or rooftops or other		
6	preexisting support structures.		
7	(c) <u>Telecommunications transmission facility coordinator</u> means the person responsible		
8	for the coordination of applications for the erection of telecommunications transmission facilities		
9	in the County.		
10	(d) Telecommunications transmission facility means any antenna mounted on a structure		
11	which is used to transmit or retransmit wireless voice, data, or image information but shall not		
12	mean or include a Minor Antenna.		
13	Sec. 2-465. Telecommunications Transmission Facility Committee.		
14	(a) The telecommunications transmission facility committee shall consist of:		
15	(1) The Director of the Department of Environmental Resources or the Director's		
16	designee;		
17	(2) The telecommunications transmission facility coordinator;		
18	(3) The Director of the Department of Public Works and Transportation, or the		
19	Director's designee;		
20	(4) The Planning Director, or the Director's designee;		
21	(5) The Superintendent of Schools or the Superintendent's designee; and		
22	(6) The Chief, Information Technology Division, Office of Management and Budget,		
23	or the Chief's designee.		
24	Sec. 2-466. Telecommunications Transmission Facility Coordinator.		
25	(a) The County Executive shall designate a telecommunications transmission facility		
26	coordinator.		
27	(b) The Director shall make available to the telecommunications transmission facility		
28	coordinator such services and facilities as are necessary for the proper performance of his duties.

1 Sec. 2-467. Committee duties and responsibilities. 2 (a) The telecommunications transmission facility committee shall promote the appropriate 3 and efficient location and co-location of telecommunications transmission facilities to minimize 4 adverse impacts on other land uses in the County. The telecommunications transmission facility 5 committee shall, among other things, evaluate the esthetic effects of locating multiple 6 telecommunications transmission facilities in a single location or on a single structure. 7 (b) The telecommunications transmission facility committee shall: (1) Recommend provisions governing removal of the proposed telecommunications 8 9 transmission facility at the end of its useful life, including the posting of a bond or other financial 10 guarantee; 11 (2) Facilitate public participation in the telecommunications transmission facility 12 siting process; and 13 (3) Report annually to the County Executive and the County Council on siting policy 14 issues. 15 Sec. 2-468. Coordinator duties and responsibilities. 16 (a) The telecommunications transmission facility coordinator shall maintain a database of 17 all telecommunications transmission facilities located in the County and those facilities proposed 18 to be located in the County. (b) The telecommunications transmission facility coordinator shall serve as a central 19 20 source of information and a technical resource on the siting of telecommunications transmission 21 facilities for County and other public landowners, private landowners, the Maryland National 22 Capital Park and Planning Commission, licensed telecommunication carriers and the general 23 public. 24 (c) The telecommunications transmission facility coordinator shall: 25 (1) review the siting of each proposed telecommunications transmission facility; (2) evaluate the technical rationale of proposed locations; and 26 27 (3) recommend alternative sites and techniques where appropriate to mitigate the 28 visual impact of the proposed and alternative site. 29 30

Sec. 2-469. Telecommunications transmission facility inventory.

- (a) Prior to August 1 of each year, each agency of the County and each agency which receives County funding shall submit to the telecommunications transmission facility coordinator its telecommunications transmission facility location plan. The plan shall identify the location of each existing telecommunications transmission facility and the proposed location of each facility to be constructed or located in the succeeding two years. The plan shall be updated whenever the actual or proposed location of a facility changes.
- (b) Prior to August 1 of each year, each owner of a telecommunications transmission facility in the County shall submit to the telecommunications transmission facility coordinator its telecommunication transmission facility location plan. The plan shall identify the location of each existing telecommunication transmission facility and the proposed location of each facility to be constructed or located in the succeeding two years.
- (c) The telecommunications transmission facility committee shall draft a master plan of actual and proposed telecommunications transmission facilities in the County and submit the master plan to the County Council for approval no later than October 1 of each year. The master plan shall identify areas of the County where additional sites for telecommunications transmission facilities are anticipated to be needed to provide service for public and private uses.

 Sec. 2-470. Telecommunications transmission facility applications.
- (a) Every applicant for a building permit or other permit for the erection of a telecommunications transmission facility shall submit to the telecommunications transmission facility coordinator a telecommunications transmission facility location plan or an amendment to an existing plan. The plan shall clearly identify the location of every existing telecommunication transmission facility and the proposed location of each facility to be constructed or located in accordance with the permit application.
- (b) Every applicant for a building permit or other permit for the erection of a telecommunications transmission facility shall submit to the telecommunications transmission facility coordinator a statement regarding whether the telecommunications transmission facility is proposed for location on an existing structure. If the application includes the construction or erection of a new supporting structure, the applicant shall provide a detailed statement describing the applicant's efforts to locate the proposed telecommunications transmission facility on an

- existing structure, a description of all alternative locations considered that do not require the construction of a new supporting structure, and an engineering study regarding the suitability of the proposed location and alternate locations for the telecommunications transmission facility.
- (c) All applications shall be reviewed in an efficient and timely manner, with the final disposition occurring within 60 days after the date a complete application is submitted to the coordinator.
- (d) Nothing herein shall exempt an applicant from any applicable zoning requirements or other requirements of law.

Sec. 2-471. Application fees.

- (a) The applicant for each telecommunications transmission facility shall pay a site review fee of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) at the time the application for a proposed location is made.
- (b) The applicant for each co-located telecommunications transmission facility shall pay a site review fee of not more than Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) at the time the application for a proposed location is made.
 - (c) The site review fee is in addition to fees required for any other permit.

Sec. 2-472. Confidentiality of telecommunications transmission facility plans.

The telecommunications transmission facility coordinator shall not disclose any information in the plan which qualifies as confidential information under the Maryland Public Information Act to any person.

Sec. 2-473. Uniform contracts for use of County facilities.

- (a) The telecommunications transmission facility committee, with the approval of the County Executive, shall develop and make available to persons desiring to erect a telecommunications transmission facility in the County a uniform contract for the location of telecommunications transmission facilities on land and structure owned and leased by the County.
- (b) The telecommunications transmission facility committee, with the approval of the County Executive, shall develop and make available to persons desiring to erect a telecommunications transmission facility in the County a uniform rent and fee schedule designed to minimize differential treatment of telecommunications transmission facility owners.
