**RESOLUTION**

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Bike to Work Day 2022

3 For the purpose of expressing the County Council’s support for declaring May 20, 2022 as Bike  
4 to Work Day in Prince George’s County as part of National Bike to Work Week, occurring  
5 during the week of May 16, 2022 through May 22, 2022 in the Washington, D.C. Metropolitan  
6 Region.

7 WHEREAS, the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board (TPB) is the  
8 metropolitan planning organization for the Washington, D.C. metropolitan region; and

9 WHEREAS, the TPB, through its Commuter Connections program and in conjunction with  
10 the Washington Area Bicyclist Association (WABA), promotes and organizes the annual Bike to  
11 Work Day event throughout the Washington, D.C. metropolitan area; and

12 WHEREAS, Bike to Work Day encourages Washington, D.C. metropolitan area residents  
13 to use bicycling as an alternative form of transportation to and from work, by registering at  
14 [www.biketoworkmetrodc.org](http://www.biketoworkmetrodc.org), and advocates for increased bicycle safety; and

15 WHEREAS, Bike to Work Day is part of the National Bike to Work Week, occurring  
16 during the week of May 16, 2022 through May 22, 2022; and

17 WHEREAS, Bike to Work Day is now celebrated in many jurisdictions in the Washington,  
18 D.C. region with over 120 locations, including pit stops in Prince George’s County at  
19 Bladensburg Waterfront Park, College Park, Greenbelt, Hyattsville, Largo/Kettering/Perrywood,  
20 Mt. Rainier, Oxon Hill/National Harbor, Port Towns - Edmonston, Riverdale Park, and University  
21 of Maryland; and

1 WHEREAS, the Prince George’s County Council is committed to promoting improved air  
2 quality, reduced traffic congestion, conservation of energy and the use of transportation  
3 alternatives in the County and Region; and

4 WHEREAS, the Capital Bikeshare program offers Prince George’s County residents more  
5 transportation options for living, working, and playing across the County and region.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Council of Prince George's  
7 County, Maryland, hereby supports and proclaims May 20, 2022, as Bike to Work Day in Prince  
8 George’s County.

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all residents of the County are encouraged to use  
10 bicycling for transportation to work on Friday, May 20, 2022, and are reminded of the  
11 importance of bicycle safety as advocated by the Street Smart Campaign and Vision Zero Prince  
12 George’s County.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this Resolution be sent by the Clerk of the  
14 Council to the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments and the National Capital  
15 Region Transportation Planning Board.
