RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 The Proposed 2001 Water and Sewer Plan

3 For the purpose of adopting the 2001 Water and Sewer Plan and the 2001 Water and Sewer
4 Category Maps, and approving a fee schedule for administering Water and Sewer Plan
5 amendments, and the purchase of maps and related materials.

6 WHEREAS, Title 9, Subtitle 5 of the Environment Article of the Annotated Code of
7 Maryland requires the County to adopt a comprehensive plan dealing with water supply and
8 sewerage systems, establishes the procedures governing the preparation and adoption of said
9 plan, and provides for amendments and revisions thereto; and

10 WHEREAS, pursuant to said procedures, the County Executive submitted to the County
11 Council his recommendations on the Proposed 2001 Water and Sewer Plan; and

12 WHEREAS, the County Council received testimony through an advertised public hearing
13 on the Proposed 2001 Water and Sewer Plan; and

14 WHEREAS, the County Council notified the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission,
15 the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission, the State and County Health
16 Departments, the Maryland Office of Planning and the Maryland Department of the Environment
17 of the public hearing and provided each agency with copies of the Proposed 2001 Water and
18 Sewer Plan.

19 SECTION 1. NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince
20 George's County, Maryland, that the Prince George's County 1994 Comprehensive Ten Year
21 Water and Sewerage Plan, as adopted by CR-71-1994, and amended by CR-90-1994,

1 CR-9-1995, CR-29-1995, CR-37-1995, CR-65-1995, CR-6-1996, CR-33-1996, CR-54-1996,
 2 CR-65-1996, CR-8-1997, CR-38-1997, CR-55-1997, CR-24-1998, CR-39-1998, CR-3-1999,
 3 CR-23-1999, CR-53-1999, CR-9-2000, CR-31-2000, CR-56-2000, CR-6-2001, and CR-29-2001
 4 is hereby amended and replaced by the 2001 Water and Sewer Plan as shown in Attachment A,
 5 attached hereto and made a part hereof.

6 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that maps identified as the “Prince George’s
 7 County, Maryland, 1994 Water Map” and “Prince George’s County, Maryland, 1994 Sewer
 8 Map”, as amended, are hereby amended and replaced by the “Prince George’s County, 2001
 9 Water Category Map” and “Prince George’s County, 2001 Sewer Category Map” located in
 10 Appendices C and D of the 2001 Water and Sewer Plan as shown in Attachment A, attached
 11 hereto and made a part hereof.

12 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Fee Schedule is hereby adopted as
 13 shown in the Appendix 6-2 of the 2001 Water and Sewer Plan as shown in Attachment A,
 14 attached hereto and made a part hereof.

15 SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Executive and the County
 16 Council shall determine that all proposed amendments to the plan are in accordance with the
 17 Category Change Policies and Criteria as adopted in Section 2.1.4 of the 2001 Water and Sewer
 18 Plan as shown in Attachment A, attached hereto and made a part hereof; and, any application
 19 may be rejected if the policies and criteria are not met.

20 SECTION 5. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the provisions of this resolution are
 21 severable and if any paragraph, provision, sentence, clause, section or part thereof is held illegal,
 22 invalid, unconstitutional, or inapplicable to any person or circumstances by a court of competent
 23 jurisdiction, such illegality, invalidity, unconstitutionality, or inapplicability shall not affect or
 24 impair any of the remaining paragraphs, provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of the
 25 resolution. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this Resolution would be adopted
 26 if such illegal, invalid, unconstitutional, or inapplicable provision, paragraph, sentence, clause,
 27 section or part had not been included herein.

28 SECTION 6. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that within five working days of the adoption
 29 of this resolution, it shall be transmitted to the County Executive by the Clerk of the Council.

30 SECTION 7. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effect on the
 31 day following the first regularly scheduled Council meeting day which occurs after the County

1 Executive transmits his comments on the resolution, or on the day that the County Executive
2 indicates he has no comments, or ten working days following the transmittal of this resolution to
3 the County Executive, whichever shall occur first. Prior to the effective date of this resolution,
4 the Council may reconsider its action based upon any recommendation received from the County
5 Executive.

6 SECTION 8. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the effective date of this resolution,
7 it shall be transmitted by the Clerk of the Council to the Secretary of the Maryland Department
8 of the Environment.
