RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

Peddlers and Itinerant Vendors

For the purpose of requesting that the Prince George's County Economic Development Corporation provide assistance to currently licensed mobile vendors in their efforts to relocate to permanent locations.

WHEREAS, CB-16-1996 was enacted by the County Council on November 26, 1996; and

WHEREAS, CB-16-1996 provides for the expiration of all licenses for peddlers and itinerant vendors selling in the public right-of-way on January 1, 1999, necessitating the relocation of existing vendors; and

WHEREAS, the Council recognizes the difficulty in identifying appropriate sites, securing the necessary financing, and obtaining the required governmental approvals; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to assist the vendors in their relocation efforts; and

WHEREAS, the Economic Development Corporation has the expertise and resources to assist the vendors in facilitating the growth of their businesses;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Prince George's County Economic Development Corporation is requested to assemble and make available to the vendors resource materials pertaining to small business development, identify existing financial assistance programs for small businesses and coordinate the processing of applications for this assistance, provide site selection assistance, and assist currently licensed vendors in the maximum utilization of

existing business development programs.
