RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Redevelopment Authority

3 For the purpose of approving the Redevelopment Authority's Statement of Procurement Policy
4 and Procurement Operating Procedures.

5 WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Authority of Prince George's County ("Redevelopment
6 Authority") was authorized by CB-85-1997 pursuant to Chapter 266 of the Laws of Maryland,
7 1996; and

8 WHEREAS, the Charter for the Redevelopment Authority was approved by the County
9 Council by CR-60-1998 and duly filed with the State of Maryland; and

10 WHEREAS, Section 4 of CB-85-1997 provides that the regulations of the
11 Redevelopment Authority shall be approved by the County Council by resolution; and

12 WHEREAS, at the Redevelopment Authority meeting held on September 7, 1999, the
13 Redevelopment Authority adopted the Statement of Procurement Policy by virtue of Resolution
14 No. 1999-4, attached hereto; and

15 WHEREAS, at the Redevelopment Authority meeting held on April 3, 2000, the
16 Redevelopment Authority adopted the Procurement Operating Procedures by virtue of
17 Resolution No. 2000-1, attached hereto; and

18 WHEREAS, at the Redevelopment Authority meeting held on October 16, 2000, the
19 Authority adopted amendments to the Statement of Procurement Policy and Procurement
20 Operating Procedures relating to the procurement of the services experts and specialists, which
21 amendments were adopted by virtue of Resolution No. 2000-3, attached hereto.

1 WHEREAS, at the Redevelopment Authority meeting held on July 2, 2001, the Authority
2 adopted amendments to the Statement of Procurement Policy and Procurement Operating
3 Procedures to encourage minority business enterprise participation in the award of Authority
4 contracts and to assure that contractors and subcontractors meet local prevailing wage
5 requirements, which amendments were adopted by virtue of Resolution No. 2001-3, attached
6 hereto.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
8 County, Maryland, that the Redevelopment Authority's Statement of Procurement Policy and
9 Procurement Operating Procedures, as amended, are hereby approved.
