BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 The Classification Plan for Prince George's County

3 For the purpose of eliminating and adding certain classes of work.

4 WHEREAS, the County Executive, pursuant to Section 903 of the Prince George's County
5 Charter and Section 16-125(a) of Subtitle 16 of the Prince George's County Code has, in order to
6 provide better governmental services, recommended to the County Council amendments to the
7 Classification Plan for Prince George's County with respect to certain classes of work described
8 within Section 1 of this Bill; now, therefore,

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
10 Maryland, that the Classification Plan for Prince George's County be and the same is hereby
11 amended as follows:

[3204L Police Recruit, L-01]
(\$46,610 - \$64,518)

3204G Public Safety Recruit, G-16
(\$33,804 - \$65,767)

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)
calendar days after it becomes law, and shall be retroactively effective to September 1, 2009.
