SECTION 1. BE I	T ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,	
Maryland, that the follo	wing amendment to Section 815, Charter of Prince George's County,	
Maryland, is hereby pro	posed:	
Sec. 815 Supplement	ary Appropriations; Staffing Level Increases.	
(a) During any fiscal ye	ar, the Council, upon recommendation of the County Executive, may, by	
resolution, make additional or supplementary appropriations from unexpended and unencumbered		
funds set aside for contingencies in the County budget, and from Federal, State or private grants		
which were not included in the budget for the current fiscal year, and may, by legislative act, make		
additional or supplement	tary appropriations from revenue received from anticipated sources but in	
excess of budget estimates therefor, from revenues received from sources not anticipated in the		
budget for the current fis	scal year and from any prior year available and uncommitted fund balance.	
(b) During any fiscal year, no agency of County government may exceed the number of positions

1	[in each grade] for that agency as approved in the operating budget without the prior approval of	
2	the Council.	
3	SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that a copy of this Act be transmitted to the	
4	County Executive for publication and that a copy also be transmitted to the Board of Supervisors	
5	of Elections for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters of this County at the 2024	
6	General Election pursuant to Section 1105 of the Charter.	
7	SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the question of adoption of this proposed	
8	Charter Amendment shall be submitted to the voters of the County at the General Election	
9	occurring on November 5, 2024, and shall be placed on the ballot in the following form:
