

which are based on construction schedules. The number of categories would be reduced from seven to five by combining the existing categories 1 thru 3 into category 3.

The amendment process is also simplified in the proposed plan. Items which are currently approved through the joint signature letter process (i.e. 4C to 3 category changes, residential allocations, transfers, and development plan amendments) would be approved administratively by the Director of DER. The Council and the Executive will have 30 days to request a joint signature prior to the administrative approval of category changes from 4C to 3.

Staff recommended an amendment to delete references to a specific update of the water and sewer maps, which allows the maps to be updated on a continuous basis. Other amendments regarding clarifying language in policy "C" (mentioned above) and limited access sewer lines (Policy "G") were also proposed. These amendments (and the corresponding amendments to CR-76) along with technical amendments to Chapter 6 of the plan were accepted by the Committee.
