BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

The proposed legislation establishes a Tax Credit Reform Commission to review and analyze all the existing and proposed tax credits in the County to determine the tax credit's effectiveness, utilization, and efficacy in the County, and to recommend reform of the tax credit policy.
