RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission

3 For the purpose of transferring certain appropriations and expenditures between certain programs
4 in the Fiscal Year 2020–21 Operating Budget for the Recreation Fund.

5 WHEREAS, the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Fiscal Year 2020–21 for
6 the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission was adopted by CB-23-2020; and

7 WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Land Use Article, Section 18-108, the budget may
8 be amended by resolution by the respective County Councils on their initiative or at the request
9 of the respective County Executives, and after public hearing upon reasonable notice to the
10 public; and

11 WHEREAS, CB-23-2020 identified funding for certain recreation programs, in particular,
12 College Park Boys and Girls Club, Maryland Cheer Chargers, and Prince George's Youth
13 Lacrosse; and

14 WHEREAS, since the adoption of CB-23-2020, it has been determined that the College
15 Park Boys and Girls Club, Maryland Cheer Chargers, and the Prince George's Youth Lacrosse
16 recreation programs will not be able to utilize the program funds as anticipated in the FY 2020–
17 21 year; and

18 WHEREAS, there is a need to increase or provide funding for the Forestville Boys and
19 Girls Club of Prince George's County, Maryland, Inc.; the Kettering-Largo-Mitchellville Boys
20 and Girls Club, Inc.; the Laurel Boys and Girls Club, Inc.; the Laurel Historical Society; and the

1 Student Athletes for Educational Opportunities (SAFEQ), Inc.; and

2 WHEREAS, in order to identify funding for these recreation programs, there is a need to
3 decrease funding in the Recreation Fund for the College Park Boys and Girls Club, Maryland
4 Cheer Chargers, and the Prince George’s Youth Lacrosse.

5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
6 County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington
7 Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that the following adjustments to the
8 approved Fiscal Year 2020–21 Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission
9 Operating Budget Recreation Fund programs, as approved in CB-23-2020, are hereby made for
10 the purposes set forth above:
