**RESOLUTION**

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 U. S. Route 301 Corridor Transportation Study

3 For the purpose of establishing a Study Group to evaluate alignment alternatives relating to the  
4 Waldorf Bypass.

5 WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of Transportation, State Highway Administration, is  
6 engaged in the U. S. Route 301 Corridor Transportation Study; and

7 WHEREAS, a portion of the study concerns the development of alternative alignments to  
8 bypass the Waldorf area in Charles County; and

9 WHEREAS, the eventual realignment of through traffic will significantly impact through  
10 and local traffic on U. S. Route 301 and Maryland Route 5 within Prince George's County,  
11 beginning at the southern border with Charles County; and

12 WHEREAS, the Charles County Citizens' Advisory Committee is in the process of  
13 analyzing and providing recommendations to the State Highway Administration for a number of  
14 alternatives under consideration for a Waldorf Bypass; and

15 WHEREAS, a study group is needed to assist the County in its evaluation of transportation  
16 priorities and alternatives under consideration by the State Highway Administration in its U. S.  
17 Route 301 Corridor Transportation Study.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's  
19 County, Maryland, that a study group be established to review the U. S. Route 301 Corridor  
20 Transportation Study alignment alternatives developed by the State Highway Administration to  
21 determine the impact upon through and local traffic in Prince George's County and to

1 recommend to the County those alternatives which minimize the impact upon segments of roads  
2 located within the County.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the study group shall consist of 7 members, 3 of whom  
4 shall be appointed by the County Executive, 3 of who shall be appointed by the County Council  
5 and a chairman selected jointly by the County Executive and the Chairman of the County  
6 Council.

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Study Group is encouraged to coordinate its efforts  
8 with the Charles County Citizens Advisory Committee through the auspices of the State  
9 Highway Administration to try to achieve a consensus on the recommendations on alternatives  
10 for both counties.
