# A RESOLUTION concerning

A Supplementary Appropriation of Federal, State and Other Funds

For the purpose of providing adjustments for grants in the amount of \$2,713,050 for the Police

Department, Fire/EMS Department, Health Department, Department of Family Services, and
the Office of Child Support Enforcement.

WHEREAS, CB-54-1997, adopted and enacted the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance of Prince George's County for Fiscal Year 1997-1998, which set forth the amount of grant funds to be appropriated; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Section 819 of the Charter of Prince George's County, Maryland, the Council, upon recommendation of the County Executive, may by resolution, make additional or supplementary appropriations from Federal, State, or private grants which were not included in the budget for the current fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, additional grant revenues have been received; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has certified in writing that such funds are available for such appropriation; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has duly recommended that the supplemental appropriations be made.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Fiscal Year 1997-1998 Approved Current Expense Budget, Federal Programs Section, is revised by supplementary appropriations as follows:

### **ATTACHMENT**

#### **EXPLANATION FOR ADDITIONAL GRANT AWARDS**

# Police Department

WEED AND SEED PROGRAM (\$75,000) - This new grant involves a coordinated strategy to further reduce illegal drug activity and lower the incidence of violence in the John Carroll Community.

OPERATION SAFE HOME (\$20,000) - Additional funds have been awarded for this joint initiative to suppress criminal activity, violence and illegal drug operations in subsidized housing.

JAMAICAN INITIATIVE (\$22,000) - This grant award will be utilized to reduce drug distribution by Jamaican trafficking organizations.

# Fire Department

FIRE ACADEMY - TERRORISM RESPONSE TRAINING (\$5,000) - The Department will receive reimbursement, as a subcontractor, for terrorism response training as designated by the U.S. Department of Justice.

HAZMAT EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS TRAINING PROGRAM (\$3,960) - This grant has been awarded by the Maryland Emergency Response Commission.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL DISPATCH TRAINING (\$9,525) - The Maryland Institute of Emergency Medical Services is providing training funding.

# **Health Department**

ADDICTED HOMELESS PERSONS SUPPORT PROJECT (\$100,000); MEDICAL ASSISTANCE TRANSPORTATION GRANT (\$53,957); LOCAL HEALTH PLANNING GRANT (\$13,125); RYAN WHITE COMPREHENSIVE CARE GRANT (\$662,459) - The Department has been informed of additional grant funding for these grant programs.

# **Department of Family Services**

AREA AGENCY ON AGING, TITLE IIIB (\$11,369); NUTRITION - CONGREGATE MEALS, TITLE C1 (\$18,460); NUTRITION - HOME-DELIVERED MEALS, TITLE C2 (\$12,043); IN-HOME HEALTH SERVICES (\$791); SENIOR HEALTH PROMOTION, TITLE IIIF (\$1,205); FOSTER GRANDPARENTS PROGRAM (\$17,166) - These Aging Services Division grants have been awarded additional grant funds or anticipate other program income over the budgeted amounts.

FRIENDLY VISITATION PROGRAM (\$25,000) - The Maryland Department of Human Resources is providing funds to support costs associated with a volunteer program for inhome visits to homebound elderly persons.

DIVISION OF CHILDREN, YOUTH AND FAMILIES (\$1,521,990) - These funds represent a reconciliation with the State of Maryland for incentive funds earned by the local program during Fiscal Years 94 through 96.

# Office of Child Support Enforcement

COOPERATIVE REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT (\$140,000) - This increase will provide for an anticipated grant agreement amendment to accommodate salary adjustments during FY98.
