This Resolution will amend the Salary Plan in Salary Schedule D, for employees in the Prince George's Correctional Officers' Association, Inc. (PGCOA) and reflects the terms and modifications of the two year Agreement (July 1, 2011 – June 30, 2013).

The Office of Law has reviewed this resolution and finds it to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its adoption.

The highlights of the Salary Plan and the fiscal impact are included in CB-53-2012.

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BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

This is companion legislation to the bill to approve the collective bargaining agreement between Prince George's County, Maryland and the Prince George's Correctional Officers' Association, Inc.
