Committee Vote: Favorable, 6-0 (In Favor: Council Members Oriadha, Olson, Dernoga, Harrison, Hunter, and Ivey)

The Committee convened on July 21, 2026, to discuss CR-72-2026, which approves four (4) locations for stop sign monitoring systems in the Town of Edmonston (listed in Attachment A), based on traffic studies conducted at specified locations:

Decatur Street (Eastbound) at 49th Avenue
Decatur Street (Westbound) at 49th Avenue
Buchanan Street at 51st Avenue
Decatur Street at 52nd Avenue

CR-72-2026 acknowledges that Edmonston has met all the requirements for location approval by sending a letter of request to the County Council, conducting traffic studies at specified locations (Attachment A), and passing a local ordinance (Attachment B) following a public hearing (Attachment C).

This resolution implements authority granted by state law (HB-364-2024) and authorized by the passage of CB-84-2024. The County legislation requires the Prince George's County Police Department to provide a report to the Governor and the Maryland General Assembly on or before December 1, providing details on the stop sign monitoring program, including:

The number of warnings and citations issued
The costs associated with the operation of the systems
Monthly revenue collections
The performance, reliability, and effectiveness of the systems in reducing violations, crashes, and pedestrian injuries

After the discussion, the Committee voted Favorably on CR-072-2026 by a vote of 6-0.
