County public fac	ilities, including roads, highways, or other public facilities, and in the event of	
any inconsistencie	es, the District Council shall direct the Planning Board on how the	
inconsistencies sh	all be eliminated or accommodated within the plan; and	
WHEREAS,	after consultation with the County Executive, the District Council may	
approve, by resolu	tion, the inclusion of any transportation line or highways proposed by the	
Planning Board fo	r planning purposes in the preliminary plan; and	
WHEREAS,	on January 25, 2008, the Planning Board transmitted the public facilities	
proposals in the pr	reliminary plan to the County Executive and the District Council; and	
WHEREAS,	the District Council has reviewed the public facilities proposals of the	
Preliminary Lando	over Gateway Sector Plan and concluded that the new and modified public	
facility transportat	tion proposals contained in the Preliminary Landover Gateway Sector Plan are	

consistent with the County's Capital Improvement Program (CIP) and the State's Consolidated Transportation Program (CTP). The District Council also recognizes that the sector plan is long range and some of the roads, highways, or public facility proposals go beyond the five-year to six-year time frame of the CTP and CIP.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, the inclusion of the proposed highways, transportation line proposals, and all other proposed public facilities in the preliminary plan as referenced in the Planning Board transmittal be and the same are hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Chairman of the Prince George's County Planning Board.
