BILL

AN ACT concerning

Animal Control

FOR the purpose of removing the requirements that additional
unannounced

inspections be conducted at least twice a year and that all facilities receive unannounced inspections.

BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

SUBTITLE 3. ANIMAL CONTROL.

Section 3-152,

The Prince George's County Code

(1991 Edition).

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that Section 3-152 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

SUBTITLE 3. ANIMAL CONTROL.

DIVISION 5. LICENSES AND STANDARDS.

Subdivision 2. Animal Holding Facility Licenses.

Sec. 3-152. Inspection of Facility.

* * * * *

(b) The Administrator shall conduct additional unannounced inspections [at least semiannually and] during regular business hours of [all] animal holding facilities in the County to insure compliance by the facilities with the requirements of this Subtitle and the regulations promulgated by the Administrator.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
