<u>CB-13-2012 - AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING COMMERCIAL ZONES - DEPARTMENT OR VARIETY STORES</u> for the purpose of amending the maximum permitted gross floor area for Department or Variety Stores. <u>PRESENTED</u>

Council Bill 13 was presented by Council Members Patterson, Harrison, Olson, Lehman, Franklin and Davis and referred to the Planning Zoning and Economic Development Committee (PZED).
