This resolution will amend the Salary Plan for Salary Schedule X for School Crossing Guards in the Police Department represented by Council 67, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, Local 241, and reflects the modifications of the two-year Agreement. (July 1, 2007 – June 30, 2009.)

The highlights of the Salary Plan and the fiscal impact are included in CB-8-2008.

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BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

This is companion legislation to the bill to approve the collective bargaining agreement between Prince George's County, Maryland and American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, and its affiliated Local 241 (School Crossing Guards) for Fiscal Years 2008 and 2009. The proposed salary plan amendments were submitted to the County Council by the County Executive on February 21, 2008. Pursuant to Section 903 of the Charter, if the Council fails to take final action on the proposed salary plan before April 21, 2008, the salary plan shall stand approved.
