RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

Repeal of the Bradford Pear Tree (Pyrus Calleryriana) as the Official Tree of Prince George's County

For the purpose of repealing the designation of the Bradford Pear Tree (Pyrus Calleryriana) as the official tree of Prince George's County.

WHEREAS, Prince George's County had designated the Bradford Pear Tree (Pyrus Calleryriana) as the County Tree for Prince George's County in the 1970s; and

WHEREAS, the Bradford Pear is a non-native Mid-Atlantic plant originating in China; and WHEREAS, the Bradford Pear is listed by the National Park Service U.S. Fish and Wildlife publication, "Plant Invaders of the Middle Atlantic Natural areas" as an ecological threat; and

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Department of Public Works and Transportation discontinued planting of the Bradford Pear in the County right of ways in the 1990s because of maintenance concerns; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the designation of the Bradford Pear Tree as the official County Tree of Prince George's County is hereby repealed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Council establishes a workgroup of interested stakeholders, including County and Planning Department staff, to review and make recommendations to the County Executive and County Council for designation of an official County Tree.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Council forward a copy of the resolution to the County Executive and the Chairman of the Prince George's County Planning
