BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

This is companion legislation to the bill to approve the collective bargaining agreement between Prince George's County, Maryland and the Prince George's County Correctional Officers' Association, Inc. (Civilian Unit) for Fiscal Years 2017 and 2018. This resolution also reflects modifications to the agreement. A fiscal impact statement will be provided by the Office of Management and Budget.

The proposed salary plan amendments were submitted to the County Council by the County Executive on September 19, 2017. Pursuant to Section 903 of the Charter, if the Council fails to take final action on the proposed salary plan before November 18, 2017, the salary plan shall stand approved.
