A RESOLUTIO	N concerning
Pro	oposed Inner Purple Line connecting New Carrollton and Bethesda
For the purpose	of establishing the Prince George's County Council's position and support
regarding fundin	g of the proposed Inner Purple Line.
WHEREAS	S, on October 21, 2001 the Governor directed the Secretary of the Maryland
Department of T	ransportation (MDOT) to make planning, funding and building the 14 mile, \$1.4
billion light rail 1	project the State's top transit priority in the Washington region; and
WHEREAS	S, the proposed Inner Purple Line will provide an east-west expansion of the
regional rail syst	em to connect Prince George's and Montgomery Counties; and
WHEREAS	S, the proposed Inner Purple Line will take thousands of cars off the Washington
region's roads, e	ncourage Smart Growth development by promoting the revitalization of the
business and resid	ential communities through which it passes, and provide much improved access for
lower-income resi	dents and college students who are most in need of transit facilities; and
WHEREAS	S, when completed in 2012, the Inner Purple Line will include stations at New
Carrollton, River	rdale, the University of Maryland (two to four stations), Takoma/Langley, Silver
Spring, Woodsid	e, West Silver Spring, Chevy Chase Lake, and downtown Bethesda; and
WHEREAS	S, the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) is in the draft FY2003
Consolidated Tra	ansportation Program (CTP) for the Washington Region and current work by the
Maryland Depar	tment of Transportation, Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority
(WMATA), in co	poperation with Prince George's and Montgomery Counties, and the Maryland-

National Capital Park and Planning Commission (M-NCPPC), is considering prospective station

locations and connecting alignments; and

WHEREAS, prospective station locations and connecting alignments are being analyzed for inclusion in the DEIS; and

WHEREAS, a Locally Preferred Alternative will be selected as the basis for more detailed engineering, right-of-way acquisition and construction as funding becomes available; and

WHEREAS, Federal funding would be a major source of construction funding and the upcoming surface transportation reauthorization legislation will play an important role in maintaining steady progress toward construction of the proposed Inner Purple Line, and

WHEREAS, Congress will approve the next Federal surface transportation reauthorization bill in 2003; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Inner Purple Line Project must be included in the surface transportation reauthorization bill to receive necessary Federal appropriations, and for completion of activities leading up to and including construction; and

WHEREAS, the Inner Purple Line from New Carrollton to Bethesda is the only version of the Purple Line that has been sufficiently studied to be eligible for earmarking in the next Federal transit funding authorization, which is due to be approved by Congress in late 2003; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the New Carrollton to Bethesda line is \$1.4 billion (Year 2003 dollars), and so its cost and cost effectiveness can compete successfully against other new rail starts for Federal funding; and

WHEREAS, the Inner Purple Line is consistent with the new General Plan for Prince George's County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Governor's recommendation, the Purple Line segments (New Carrollton to Bethesda, and Branch Avenue to Alexandria) will be added to the transportation master plans in Prince George's and Montgomery Counties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the County Council hereby expresses its strong support for the Inner Purple Line between New Carrollton and Bethesda and urges that the Maryland Department of Transportation proceed diligently to complete the environmental studies, design, land acquisition and construction of the Inner Purple Line from New Carrollton to Bethesda and that the United States Senators and Representatives support the earmarking of the Federal authorization for the Inner Purple Line; and that the Governor and General Assembly provide the State financial support on an expedited basis.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the effective date of this resolution it shall be transmitted by the Clerk of the Council to the Governor-Elect, General Assembly, Maryland Congressional Delegation, Council of Governments/Transportation Planning Board, MDOT, WMATA, M-NCPPC and Department of Public Works and Transportation.
